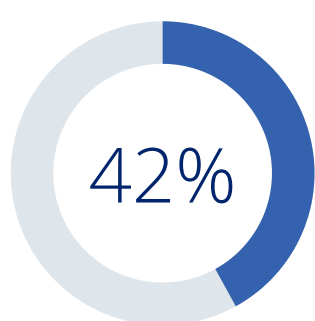


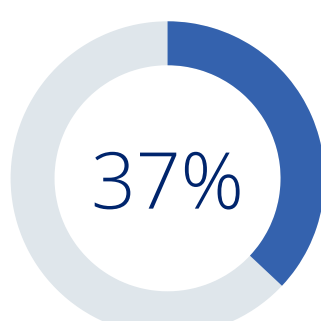

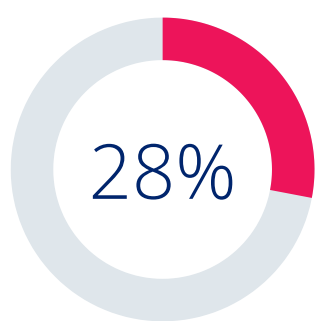
Budget Sufficiency



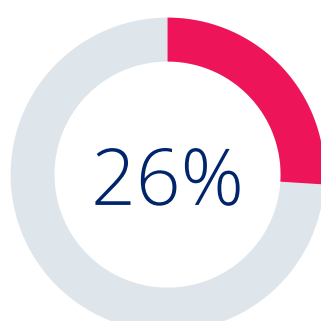
Budget is sufficient to fulfill Title IX training needs



Budget provides for sufficient number of trained investigators

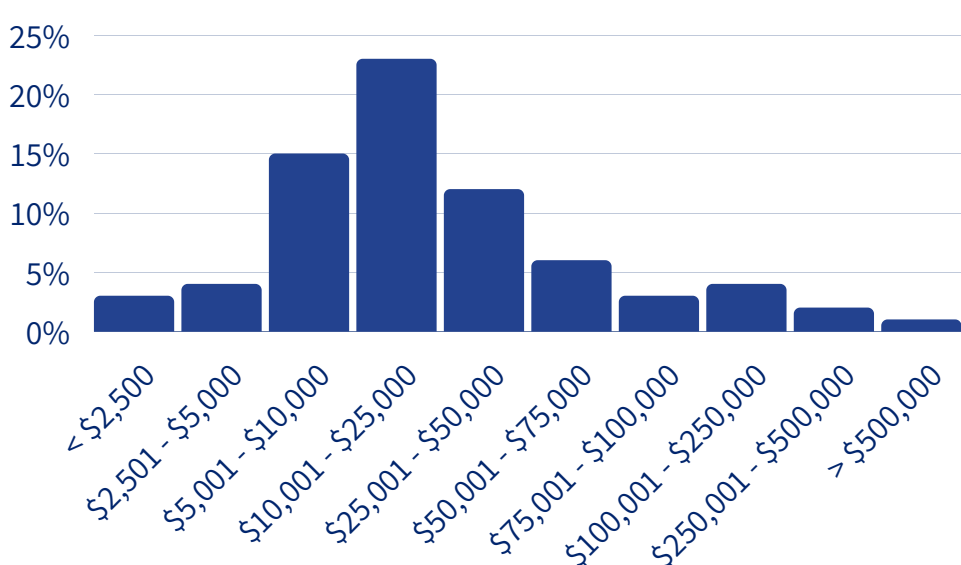


Budget provides for sufficient number of advisors



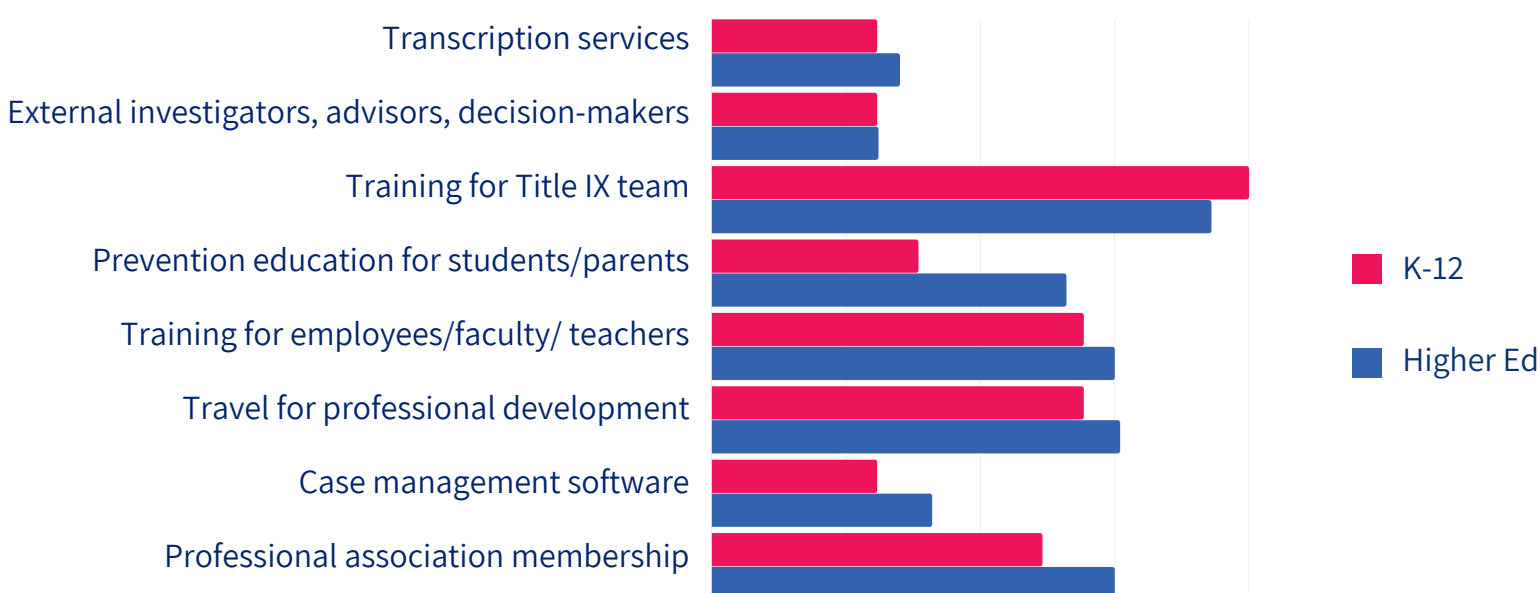

57% have a budget associated with their Title IX office/compliance efforts

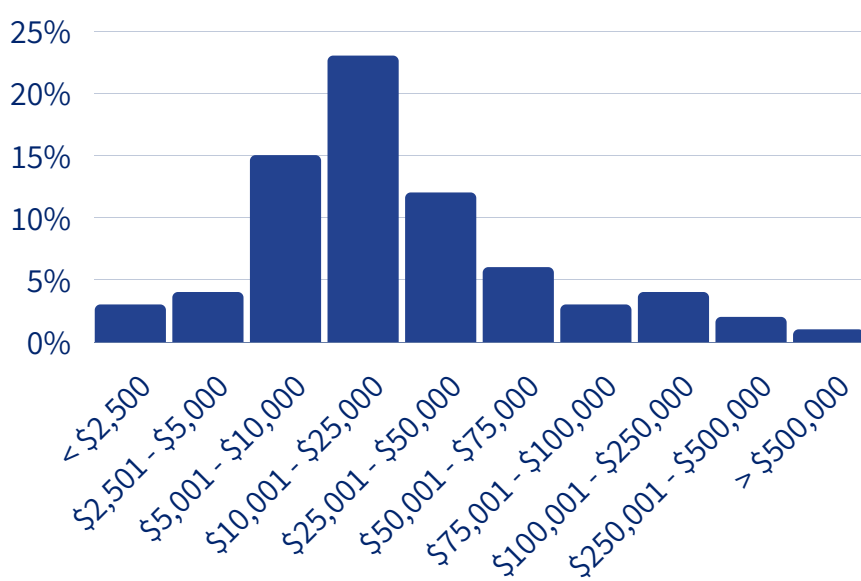
Title Budget Coverage

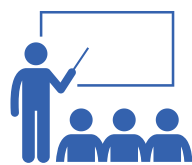
What Resources Do You Need to Aid in Your Compliance Efforts?

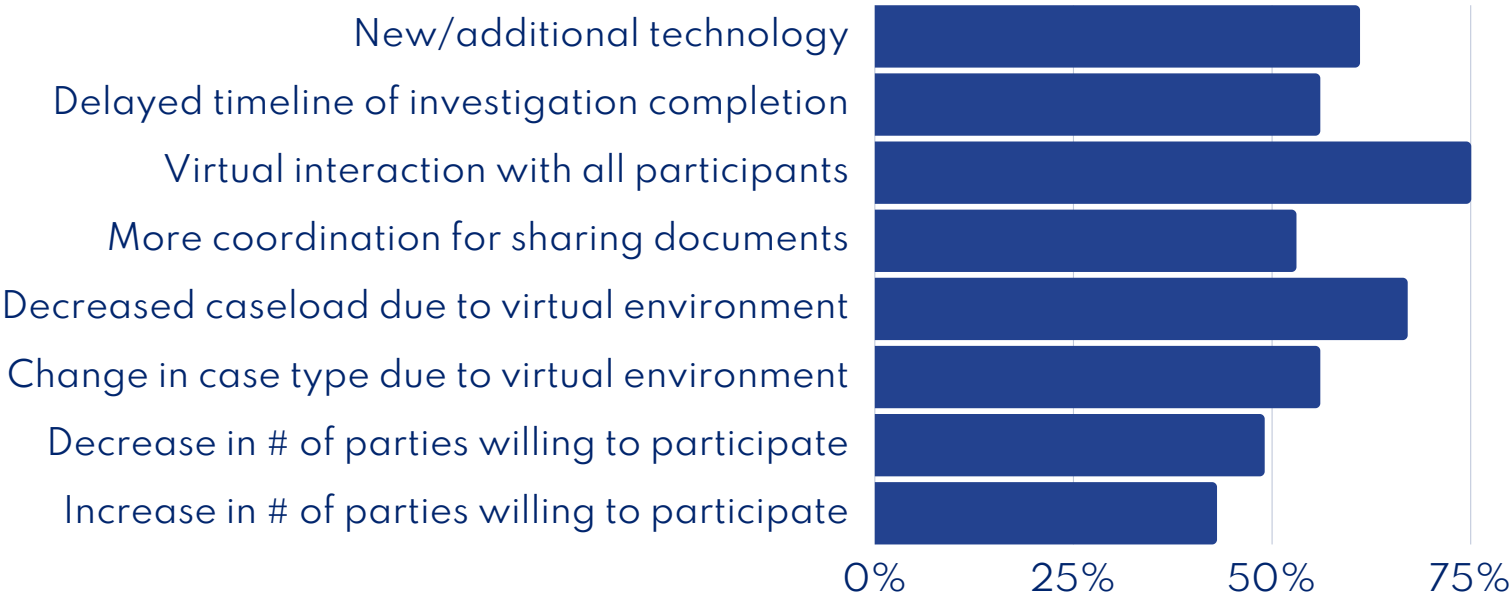

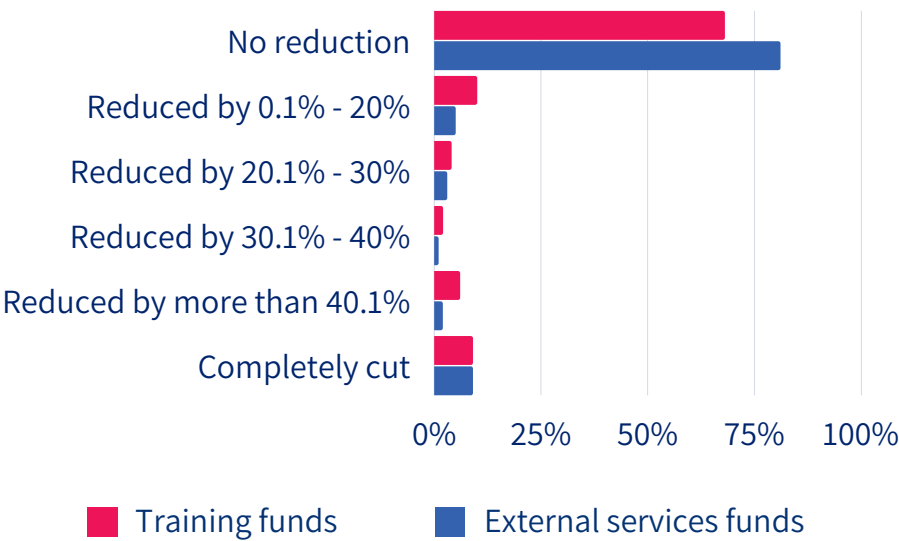

Impact of COVID-19 on Investigation Processes

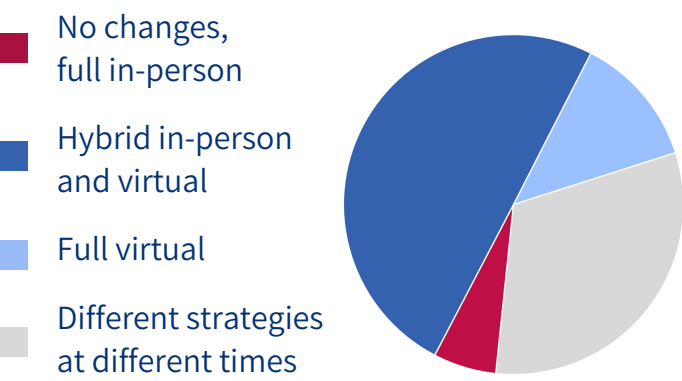
